NEW FEDERAL REGULATION REQUIREMENTS FOR FUEL STORAGE TANK OWNER/USERS

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) initiated new inspection regulations under the Oil Pollution Prevention Regulation (OPPR) or 40CFR112, in which Spill Prevention Control and Countermeasures (SPCC) Plans and tanks must meet compliance by **November 10, 2010**. If a facility has a total above-ground storage capacity greater than 1,320 gallons, to include 55 gallon containers and greater, these regulations apply. These capacities must be found compliant and in accordance with the STI guidelines of the Steel Tank Institute Inspection Program SPO01-03 or API 653 Above Ground Storage Tank Inspection Standard. Re-inspection compliance schedules shall be performed in a time period determined by a certified inspector.

API Standard 653 is the standard for inspection of in-service and out-of-service above ground storage tanks (AST) for storage of combustible and flammable liquids. Tanks under ADEC Regulatory Compliance are inspected externally every five years for corrosion and/or failures and inspected internally a required maximum of every 20 years for corrosion and failures of the internal tanks. API 570 Piping Inspections for external piping and Cathodic Protection Inspections are conducted in compliance with ADEC Regulations and buried piping inspections are conducted every three years.

If a facility has a total above-ground storage capacity greater than 10,000 gallons, then SPCC plans must be signed-off by a professional engineer (PE) by **November 10, 2010**.
