OLGOONIK CORPORATION is proud to offer enrollment to Native descendants of original OLGOONIK CORPORATION shareholders.

The OLGOONIK CORPORATION Board has adopted certain terms and conditions to prevent the dual enrollment of Natives in OLGOONIK CORPORATION and in other village corporations that have enrollment programs for new Natives. This means that parents who are enrolled in two different village corporations with new enrollment programs must decide which village corporation to enroll their children. A check system is in place between OLGOONIK CORPORATION and other village corporations to avoid dual enrollment.

The OLGOONIK CORPORATION Board of Directors also approved the following guidelines to the enrollment program, which become effective immediately:

1. An individual is eligible to receive Class B stock if:
 - a. He or she is Native (as defined in ANCSA); and
 - b. He or she is born after December 18, 1971; and
 - c. He or she is a citizen of the United States; and
 - d. He or she is a lineal descendant of at least one person who holds or held Class A stock that was originally issued directly to that person by OLGOONIK CORPORATION. A Native person who has been legally adopted shall be considered the lineal descendant of both his or her natural and his or her adoptive parents; and
 - e. He or she has not been enrolled as a shareholder in any other village corporation organized pursuant to ANCSA.
2. An individual is eligible to receive Class B stock if he or she met all of the original enrollment requirements for issuance of Class A shares in OLGOONIK CORPORATION, but missed the deadline for original enrollment in OLGOONIK CORPORATION.
3. Grandparents may enroll their minor grandchildren but must provide documented proof of their responsibility for the minor, such as affidavits from a tribal government or State-ordered guardianship.

4. A State agency may complete an enrollment application for a minor in State custody where the parental rights of both parents have been terminated. While such children will be enrolled in OLGOONIK CORPORATION, their shares and dividends will be held in trust until adoption, appointment of a legal guardian, or they reach the age of 18 years.
5. Legal guardians may enroll their wards as long as the minor applicant meets the eligibility requirements for enrollment.

1. PHOTOCOPY OF SOCIAL SECURITY CARD OR PROOF OF SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER
2. ORIGINAL OR CERTIFIED BIRTH CERTIFICATE (copies not accepted)
3. COMPLETED CUSTODIAL CONSENT FORM (IF APPLICANT IS A MINOR)
4. COMPLETED FAMILY TREE FORM (BLOOD QUANTUM REQUIRED)
5. COURT APPROVED ADOPTION DECREE (IF APPLICABLE)
6. SHAREHOLDER STATUS FORM AND RELEASE FOR VERIFICATION

THE ENROLLMENT APPLICATION WILL NOT BE PROCESSED UNTIL ALL DOCUMENTATION IS COMPLETE. ALL INFORMATION PROVIDED WILL BE HELD CONFIDENTIAL.

As soon as all required documents are received by OLGOONIK CORPORATION, the enrollment application will be processed by the Heirship Committee. Applicants will be notified in writing if further documentation is required; if the application has been approved; and/or if the application has been denied. If the Applicant has been denied enrollment, an explanation of the appeals process will also be provided. A photocopy of the original stock certificate will be mailed to new enrollees.

WEST'S ALASKA STATUTES
TITLE 13. DECEDENTS' ESTATES, GUARDIANSHIPS, TRANSFERS, AND TRUSTS
CHAPTER 46. ALASKA UNIFORM TRANSFERS TO MINORS ACT

§ 13.46.110. Care of custodial property

(a) A custodian shall

- (1) take control of custodial property;
- (2) register or record title to custodial property if appropriate; and
- (3) collect, hold, manage, invest, and reinvest custodial property.

(b) In dealing with custodial property, a custodian shall observe the standard of care that would be observed by a prudent person dealing with property of another and is not limited by any other statute, except AS 13.90.010, restricting investments by fiduciaries. If a custodian has a special skill or expertise or is named custodian on the basis of representations of a special skill or expertise, the custodian shall use that skill or expertise. However, a custodian, in the custodian's discretion and without liability to the minor or the minor's estate, may retain custodial property received from a transferor.

(c) A custodian may invest in or pay premiums on life insurance or endowment policies on

(1) the life of the minor only if the minor or the minor's estate is the sole beneficiary;
or

(2) the life of another person in whom the minor has an insurable interest only to the extent that the minor, the minor's estate, or the custodian in the capacity of custodian, is the irrevocable beneficiary.

(d) A custodian at all times shall keep custodial property separate and distinct from all other property in a manner sufficient to identify it clearly as custodial property of the minor. Custodial property consisting of an undivided interest is so identified if the minor's interest is held as a tenant in common and is fixed. Custodial property subject to recordation is so identified if it is recorded, and custodial property subject to registration is so identified if it is either registered, or held in an account designated, in the name of the custodian, followed in substance by the words: "as a custodian for _____ (name of minor) under the Alaska Uniform Transfers to Minors Act."

(e) A custodian shall keep records of all transactions with respect to custodial property, including information necessary for the preparation of the minor's tax returns, and shall make them available for inspection at reasonable intervals by a parent or legal representative of the minor or by the minor if the minor has attained the age of 14 years.
